EPA researchers partnered with WaterStep to develop an emergency mobile water treatment system called Water on Wheels, or WOWCart.

"Following a natural disaster, communities need access to clean water for not only drinking, but for mobile kitchens, showers, laundry, and medical triage," senior science advisor at the U.S. EPA Office of Research and Development, Jim Goodrich, Ph.D., said. "Bottled water is impractical for these needs and also creates a large solid waste problem... the WOWCart can address a wide range of germs and harmful chemicals, making water safer."

In addition to producing 10k gallons of safe water daily, this patented system produces a chlorine bleach solution for mold removal and general sanitation.

WOWCART FACTS

1 Multi Source Safe Water

Connect to municipal water lines, or pull from local streams, lakes, or rivers to reduce traffic and waste from tankers and plastic bottles.

2. 10K Gallons of Safe Water Daily

Treat water and fill bladders, tanks, or tanker trucks and distribute up to 10K gallons daily.

3. Remove Pollutants & Chemicals

Carbon filtration removes petroleum and heavy chemicals. Additional filtration options available.

4. Continuous Bleach Production

Black mold is a major problem following flooding events. Produce medical-grade bleach on-site for use in clean-up and medical efforts.

5. Compact & Easily Portable

Fits into a truck bed and can be transported and moved by just two individuals.
